The Aging Institute of UPMC Senior Services and the University of Pittsburgh invites you to apply for a \$2,500 UPMC employee scholarship for the University’s Graduate Certificate in Gerontology program. This opportunity is open to both direct care and non-direct care staff.

Two \$2,500 scholarships will be awarded.

Scholarships can be used simultaneously with the UPMC tuition benefit and must be applied to the 2017-18 academic year.

Applications are encouraged from employees who:

- Have worked full-time at UPMC for a minimum of two years.
- Work with older adults or are looking to begin a career in the geriatric field.
- Have a bachelor’s degree.
- Meet general admission criteria for the Graduate Certificate in Gerontology Program.

The Graduate Certificate in Gerontology program offers specialization tracks in gerontechnology, law, mental health, nursing, occupational therapy/rehabilitation, public health, and social work as well as two multidisciplinary tracks—**general** and **prevention and healthy aging**. **The general multidisciplinary track also is offered through Pitt Online.**

Application deadline is August 14, 2017.

Required application materials include:

1. A one-page letter of intent that describes your financial need for the scholarship.
2. Two letters of recommendation.
